ASPIRE of North Delta Mississippi Celebrates First Community Event

ASPIRE of North Delta Mississippi (NDMS) held its first community event on Tuesday, April 23, 2013 at the Cutrer Mansion in Clarksdale, Mississippi. Members from the community enjoyed the festivities. Those attending heard about ASPIRE and the benefits of the program from Board Chairman Charles Butler, Co-Chairman Orlando Paden and the scholarship recipients.

The NDMS Affiliate receives funding through a grant given by the Delta Bridge Project (DBP) for students who live in Coahoma County, Mississippi only—additional funds raised by the board and the community-at-large support scholarships for non-Coahoma County residents. Students supported by the DBP grant get \$1,000 scholarships per semester, while non-DBP funded students receive \$500 scholarships per semester.

ASPIRE of North Delta Mississippi has awarded 12 scholarships to-date. Board members are hopeful that with dedicated fundraising, the board will be able to increase the amount of non-DBP scholarships they are able to award per semester.




ASPIRE of Southwest Missouri Highlights Recent Graduate

ASPIRE of GCOK saw one student graduate in March from a nursing program, and another student complete her basic courses at the community college and is now enrolled at ORU.

ASPIRE Improves STAR Database

National ASPIRE has been working diligently over the past few months updating the STAR (Student Tracking and Records) Database so that it is more user-friendly for students and Affiliates. Some of the more notable improvements for students have been: an initial screening process so that applicants know immediately if they qualify; a multi-screen application that allows students to save their information and return at a later time; and the ability for applicants to upload supporting documents, eliminating the problem of losing information in the mail. These updates will make it easier for our Affiliates to have the required student information readily accessible to them.
